Anadarko is ...

Committed to sustainable operations. Energy is fundamental to physical existence, along with clean air, water and affordable food. Anadarko is committed to its responsibility to find and produce these energy resources that are essential for the world's health and welfare, and to doing so in a safe and sustainable manner for our environment, our employees and the communities in which we operate. Many of our employees are geologists, hydrologists, engineers, geophysicists and other earth scientists. We understand our natural world, appreciate it and most of all – respect it.

Tailoring our operations to accommodate wildlife habitat, and monitoring populations of local species and migration patterns of big game are key elements of our efforts to balance energy development and the natural world. Other industry-leading examples of the company's environmental stewardship include our CO₂ sequestration operations in Wyoming, utilization of directional and horizontal drilling practices that reduce the amount of surface space needed for producing energy resources, innovative recycling and water-management programs, reclamation and restoration of natural vegetation, and volunteer efforts aimed at giving back to, and enhancing the quality of life in our communities.

Anadarko is ...

Doing its part to reduce emissions and improve air quality. In 2010, Anadarko achieved the environmental leadership status of Climate Registered™ by successfully registering its comprehensive greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions inventory according to the rigorous standards of The Climate Registry. Participation in The Registry's voluntary program demonstrates Anadarko's pioneering role within the energy industry. Additionally, as a leading producer of clean-burning natural gas, Anadarko has been instrumental in efforts to expand the utilization of this cleaner, abundant, domestic fuel source.

Natural gas is domestic. It creates jobs, spurs economic activity, provides cleaner electricity generation, and is the only realistic alternative to displace foreign oil in certain areas of transportation. Anadarko has been actively engaged at the local, state and federal levels to encourage greater utilization of domestic natural gas. These efforts were successful in Colorado where the Colorado Clean Air, Clean Jobs Act was signed into law in 2010. This act will require that older, coal-fired electric generation be replaced or retrofitted to run on natural gas or other alternatives. Anadarko also was instrumental in the creation of the Ground Water Protection Council's public registry, which will provide greater transparency through the voluntary disclosure of ingredients used in fracture-stimulation applications.



Anadarko is ...

Creating a better world for generations to come. We work to achieve this goal through community partnerships, sensitivity to cultural issues and social investment wherever we operate. From job creation and specialized training in Algeria, as well as educational support in West Africa and Brazil, to increased access to clean drinking water in Mozambique, Anadarko understands our responsibility to extend opportunities for prosperity, as we expand our global operations.

In 2010, Anadarko's employees volunteered more than 30,000 hours of their own time to community service and charitable projects. Examples of our role in the community include:

- **Providing educational support** through elementary school reading programs in Indonesia, university coursework in Liberia, educational seminars for indigenous populations and Junior Achievement classes across our U.S. operations.
- **Helping to eradicate hunger** through support of food pantries worldwide and activities such as nutrition seminar in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, and culinary courses in Algeria.
- **Building Stronger Communities** through efforts such as an 11-year partnership in building homes with Habitat for Humanity in the U.S., floral design workshops for women with disabilities in Algeria and partnering with local craftsmen to construct school furniture in Sierra Leone.
- **Working with care for the environment and surrounding communities** by funding programs that restore mechanical integrity to water distribution systems in Mozambique, using chase boats to inform local fishermen of seismic activities in East Africa or providing tools for trail restoration and reclamation projects in Pennsylvania and Wyoming.
- **Donating emergency relief and financial support** where we operate and through employee philanthropic campaigns that contributed more than \$2 million to the United Way in 2010 alone.

Anadarko is ...

Committed to the belief that safety is no accident. Through various safety programs including LiveSafe and SafeStart, Anadarko places priority on the safety and health of our employees, contractors and stakeholders. In 2011, the company also announced partnerships with two industry consortiums aimed at rapid response and containment in the deepwater Gulf of Mexico: the Marine Well Containment Company and the Helix Well Containment Group.
