## Emphasizing Summer Safety in our Schools

As a company of men and women who share a commitment to safety and being a good neighbor in northeast Colorado, Anadarko regularly seeks out opportunities to share information on the oil and natural gas industry with safety as a focus. We partner with local school districts and first responders to host Safety Matters – a one-hour session providing high school and junior high students with summer tips on safe driving, fire prevention, oil field safety, swim safety, and drug and alcohol abuse.

## Engaging First Responders

We engage local officials in the community, from local EMS and Air Evacuation teams to hospitals, fire, police and Sheriff's Department personnel.

The involvement of these first responders enables students to feel comfortable approaching these men and women, and provides one-on-one setting to discuss real safety issues facing the community. Our ultimate goal is for students to place an emphasis on the need to make safe choices and keep their well-being as a priority in everything they do.

## Making Safe Choices

Anadarko first conducted this event in two south Texas school districts in 2011. We have also expanded the program to reach students at Pecos and Wink High School in West Texas with similar success. In total, Anadarko has hosted safety events on 10 occasions. Here's how it works:

- A principal or counselor delivers opening remarks
- Students break up into four groups, each led by 1-2 first responders to discuss a specific safety issue they encounter on a regular basis
- Students rotate every 15 minutes
- At the end of all four mini-sessions, each student receives a T-shirt as our symbol of appreciation for their attention to safety matters. Students are also asked to provide feedback on a lesson they learned from each session.
