Anadarko is responsibly producing clean-burning natural gas and natural gas liquids (NGLs) that are used as a major domestic fuel source and in the manufacturing of many of our consumer and industrial goods. The largest producer of natural gas in Utah, Anadarko produces enough natural gas to power more than 1.9 million average American homes every day and is committed to prudent and responsible operations. The company seeks to maximize the benefits of energy development for the communities of the Uinta Basin, while minimizing the surface disturbance of our operations.

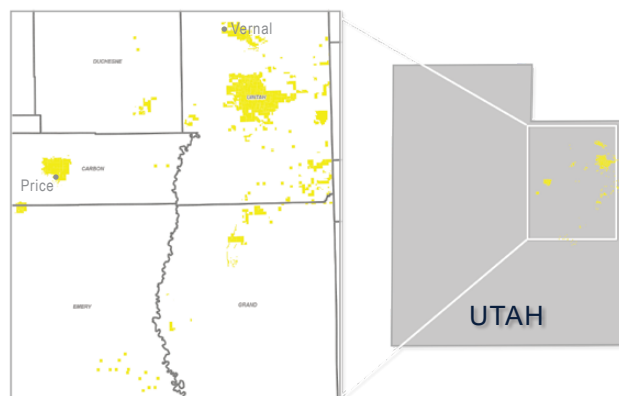
